



Conditions of Entry to Darwin Basketball Association (including Spectrum Stadium)

- Management reserves the right to refuse entry
- Persons gaining unauthorized access to the Facility may be liable for prosecution
- Patrons who cause a disturbance, or refuse to comply with requests made by staff will be evicted from the Facility
- This Facility is monitored by closed-circuit TV at all times
- Smoking is permitted only in designated areas
- Persons who bring valuables into the Facility do so at their own risk
- No animals permitted (guide dogs excepted)
- The use of mobile phones and cameras in toilets and change rooms is prohibited
- Children must be closely supervised by an adult (18+ years)
- The Facility caters for all food and beverage requirements. Commercial fast food is not permitted in the Facility
- Exits must be kept clear at all times.
- No using fire exits except in genuine emergencies.
- Stairways to be kept clear at all times.
- Footwear must be worn at all times.
- No Bubble gum or chewing gum allowed into the venue.
- Basketballs must be kept under wrap whilst competition games are in play. Team Balls should be kept in a bag behind the team bench.
- Spectators/players bouncing a ball courtside will be asked to stop. If this behaviour continues they will be asked to hand the ball to the ticket office for collection on departure or to leave the venue.
- No swearing, offensive or abusive language.
- Not verbally or physically intimidate or threaten staff or users.
- T-shirts, singlet should be worn at all times during Competition times.
- Courtsiding is prohibited.
- Anyone who is suspected of courtsiding will be asked to cease immediately.
- Anyone who continues to courtside will be ejected and barred from the venue.
- Respect the facility and other users at all times.
- Risk Warning under Section 5M of the Civil Liability Act 2002: Players, spectators, officials and all other visitors are warned that the recreational activities undertaken in these Facilities involve the risk of injury

Refusal to comply with these Conditions of Entry may result in removal from the venue. The Conditions of Entry are subject to change without notice

Restricted/Prohibited Items

Management reserves the right to inspect/search bags brought into or out of the Facility

The following items are not permitted to be brought into the Facility:

- Alcoholic Beverages (other than those purchased from DBA)
- Flares/Fireworks
- Laser pointers
- Knives or other dangerous weapons
- Skateboards, scooters
- Other similar items that have the potential to cause injury or nuisance
- Facility Management reserves the right to deny entry to those in possession of any item they deem inappropriate.

Liquor Licencing

All persons entering Darwin Basketball Association Stadium (Including Spectrum Stadium) are advised that:

- They are entering licenced premises
- Intoxicated persons will not be permitted to enter
- Checking procedures will apply to prevent persons possessing liquor from entering
- Intoxicated persons will be removed from the premises
- It is an offence for minors to purchase and consume liquor
- It is an offence to purchase liquor for (or supply liquor to) minors
- It is an offence to take liquor off the premises.
- It is an offence to drink alcohol in a public place (unlicensed area) e.g. car park
- Persons supplying liquor to minors will be reported to the Police and penalties apply under the Liquor Act 2007
